

Dunk Tank Setup Instructions:

Setup will require two people and should take approximately 15 min to assemble and 30-90 minutes to fill. If you have questions during setup or use, call us at 330 752-2351. Do not force any parts into place; if they don't go in easily, they are in the wrong position.



1. Find a flat and dirt free area that will allow water to drain into a trouble free zone.
 2. Set up 4 large panels on the ground. The unique back panel should be set first. This panel is the one with the seat attached.

3. Each piece is numbered 1-4, match the numbers and connect.

4. Install the blue tub liner by wrapping the nylon and velcro strap around the top horizontal frame. The plastic viewing window must face the ball thrower.

5. Make sure the liner is pulled tight to the edges so there are no creases on the bottom. Failure to ensure liner is in correctly will result in liner collapsing during fill up. If this happens, drain and start step 4 again.

6. Slide the horizontal paddle assembly onto the seat assembly. Make sure the paddle is in a vertical (upright) position.



7. Then slot the paddle assembly support bracket (it swivels) into the back panel.



8. Slot both upper panels onto the main frame. The panels must be placed in the front and right side of dunk tank as viewed from the ball throwers perspective. Do not force panels in, if it doesn't fit, use the other panel.

9. Insert the step in the back left corner, inside the dunk tank



10. The final step is to sleeve the yellow back stop onto the back drop pole.



11. Your dunk tank should look like this when finished.

SAFETY RULES:

1. Adult Supervision required at all times.
2. Keep Dunk Tank away from electricity.
3. Keep water level filled at least 8" from top of tank.
4. Only one person at a time allowed on seat or in tank.
5. Keep all non swimmers less than 5' tall out of tank.
6. Advise Dunkee to move towards front of tank when coming up out of water to avoid hitting head on the seat.
7. Drain tank when unattended.
8. NEVER stand on seat.
9. When on seat, sit in the middle of the seat and keep hands on lap.
10. Do NOT hit target with hands, Dunkee may not be ready.
11. Do not operate dunk tank during bad weather, lightning, or a storm.
12. Do not use alcohol or drugs while operating dunk tank.
13. Persons with physical or mental impairment should not be permitted on dunk tank.
14. Maintain water quality by changing water frequently.
15. Call appropriate emergency responders if necessary.

Adult Supervision required at all times

Non returned balls will be charged at \$10.00 each.

There is a \$25.00 cleaning charge that will apply to each unit that is not cleaned upon return. All Dunk Tanks must be returned in the SAME condition they were received—THOROUGHLY CLEANED AND READY FOR USE .
